FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

Plymouth Oil Company plans to permanently plug and abandon the above referenced well utilizing the following general procedure:

1. Cut and recover approximately 5945' of 7" oil string casing.
2. Place a 15 sack cement plug from 9500' to 9425' above perms. in Wolfcamp.
3. Place a 20 sack plug in bottom of intermediate string, from 4213' to 4163'.
4. Place a 20 sack plug in top of intermediate string at surface with required 4" pipe marker complete with location markings.
5. All annular spaces between plugs to be filled with a mud laden fluid.
