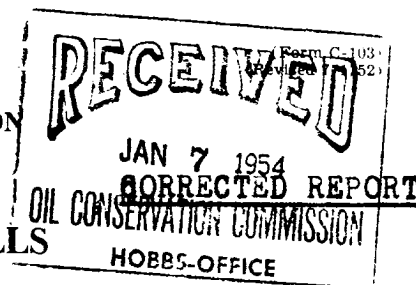

13 3/8" surface pipe was set @ 499' with 500 sacks. 13 3/8" surface pipe was tested to 1000 psi for thirty minutes. Pressure at start of test 1000 psi. Pressure at end of the test 990 psi. Cement circulated.
