DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Set 9 5/8" casing at 3910', using 12 centralizers, 86 scratchers and 3,565 sacks cement. Plug down at 8:40 P.M., 9-13-53, 900# pumping pressure. Temperature survey showed top cement at 530'.

On September 20, 1953, drilled out plug. Tested casing with 1,000# pressure for 30 minutes before and after drilling plug. No pressure drop.
