Set 5 1/2" casing at 13,498', using 250 scratchers and 50 centralizers, cemented with 1,150 sacks cement. Plug down at 9:20 P.M. 11-8-54. Top cement by temperature survey 7912'.

Tested casing with 1500# pressure before drilling plug. No pressure drop. Drilled out plug to 13,488'. Tested casing with 1500# pressure after drilling plug. No pressure drop.
