Set 9 5/8" casing at 4,200', using 12 cementizers, 85 sacks cement and 3,775 sacks cement. Plug down at 2:20 P.M. May 29, 1953. Cement circulated.

On May 31, 1953, after 45 hours WOC, tested casing with 1,000# pressure before drilling plug. No pressure drop.

Drilled out cement and tested casing with 1,000# pressure. No pressure drop.
