Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of August 27, 1962, wherein you point out the difficulty of drilling in the previously authorized 9970-9815' zone in the Unit No. 8 and request administrative approval to perforate additional zones from 9970' to 10,325' selectively.

Inasmuch as the additional sections to be opened to salt water disposal are well below the productive Wolfcamp formation and are in fact considerably lower even than previously authorized zone, the Commission has no objection to your proposal.

Continental Oil Company is, therefore, hereby authorized to dispose of produced salt water in the intervals 9970-10,025, 10,025-10,050, 10,050-10,100, and 10,325-10,350' in addition to the interval 9970-9815' heretofore authorized by Commission Order No. 2-2078, Case 2387.
