FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

Subject well was completed at TD 13,689', DOD 13,659' as a dry hole in the Devonian formation & was temporarily abandoned 6-17-54. Testing in the Devonian, Pennsylvanian and Wolfcamp formations failed to yield commercial production.

Permission is requested to convert this temporarily abandoned well to a salt water disposal well in the Upper Wolfcamp pay. The following procedure will be followed: Squeeze perforations 12,173-92', plug back to approximately 10,000', perforate Wolfcamp 9,776-9,816' with 4 JSPP, and acidize with 5,000 gallons.

NMOCC Order No. R-2078, dated October 9, 1961, approves the conversion of this well to salt water disposal in the Wolfcamp.

A subsequent report will be filed upon completion of the above work.
