The subject well was plugged and abandoned as a dry hole. T.D. 13,689', PHD 12,431'. Plugging started 11-15-54 and completed 12-2-54. Following plugs were set:
 12,303-12,431' with 25 sacks cement
 7,550-7,650'
 4,171-4,271' with 80 sacks cement
 0-50'

Pulled 107 joints 7" OD casing, shot off at 7600'. A 4" marker was erected and location restored to original condition.
