This well was drilled to the base of the salt at 1959 ft. and as the

structure was found to be low drilling was stoomed at that point. 10-3/4" casing was set at 75 ft. and 8-5/8" at 750 ft., both strings being mudded.
Pursuant to notice dated May 3, 1951, and filed and approved May 16,
the well was plugged as follows: On May 29, the hole was filled through tubing with mud, using 75 sacks of Ez-Mix mud material. A ten sack coment plug was placed through tubing from 877' to approximately 850'. The casing was shot at 600 ft., and again at 480 ft. before it could be pulled. Two hundred seventy ft. of 8-5/8" pipe was left in the well, extending from 480' to 750' below the surface. The 10-3/4" casing was pulled and a regulation marker was comented in place with 10 sacks coment and the surface leveled.
