DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Set 13 3/8" OD casing at 603', cemented with 600 sacks cement, using 4 centralizers. Plug down at 9:45 P.M. 12-29-54. Cement failed to circulate. Temperature survey showed top of cement at 351'.

Ran 1" pipe outside 13 3/8" surface casing to 110', and pumped in 250 sacks cement. Still did not circulate. Pumped in additional 100 sacks cement, circulated to surface. Plug down at 5:00 P.M. 12-30-54.

Tested casing with 500# pressure before and after drilling plug. No pressure drop.
