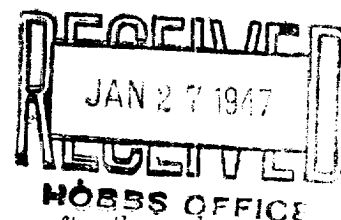

## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

12/10 Drilling String 7" casing set at 3,556' to shut off water encountered in Artesia Red Sand. Tested for shut-off and Drilled ahead. 12/20 Ran 4210 (4110') 5-1/2" OD New casing to bottom - Halliburton Cemented 100 sax. 12/21 Pulled all 7" drilling string. 12/26 Drilled cement plug, Tested for shut-off and found okeh. Drilled ahead and reached TD4323' on 1/18/47. Shot well 1/20 '47 with 360 quarts Glycerin. Cleaning out after shot. Natural production tested 12 barrels daily by swabbing & Bailing. After cleaning out well should produce about 50 barrels per day..
