DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Excessive water was encountered in the Artesia Red Sand 3392-3410 and it was necessary to run string of 7" casing to shut off this water. Pipe was run 11/10/44. Was mudded as it is our intention to pull this pipe after oil string is run and cemented. Pipe was set down on 11/17, hole bailed dry and tested satisfactory for water shut-off. Drilled out of pipe 11/18. Running 7" casing at this point will necessitate change of oil string from 7" to 5-1/2".
