Killed well with 85 barrels oil. Shot 140 quarts SNG from 4170' to 4230'; anchor 4298-30', gravel 4170-60', 12 sacks Calseal 4160-4090'. Shot exploded 10:30 A.M., April 29, 1945. Well was then cleaned out and swabbed. Flowed 30 minutes, 70 oil, 50 net oil.
