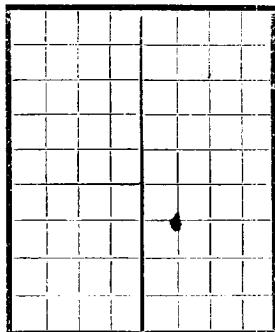

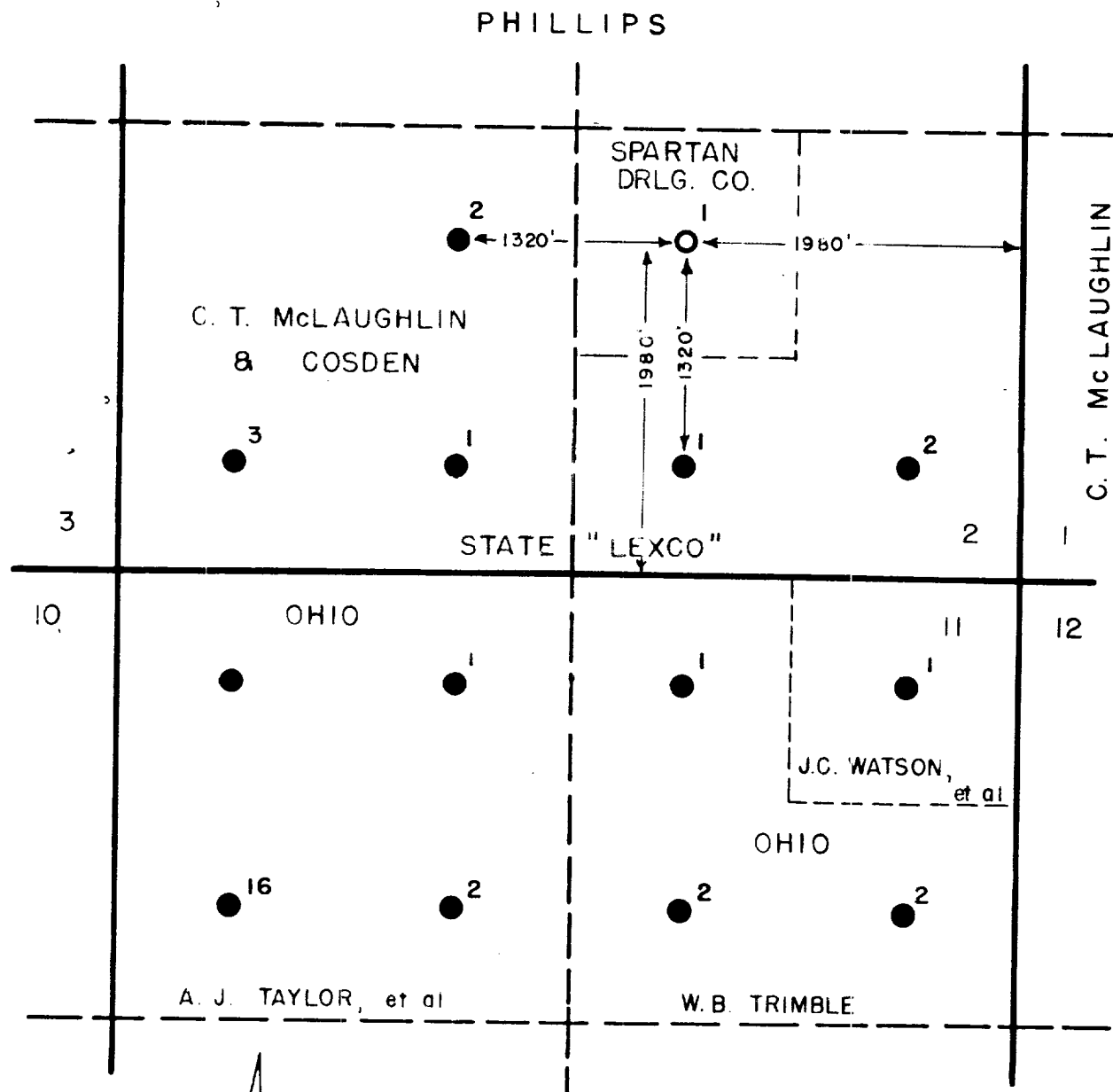

Dear Sir:

We have just received your Form C-101, Notice of Intention to Drill, State #1, Sec. 2, T. 17S, R. 32E, Lea County, New Mexico.

I cannot approve your casing program on this well. It will be necessary for you to use approximately 260' of surface casing to protect the fresh water section or cement the 8 5/8" casing with an adequate amount of cement to circulate back to surface.

Your Bond has been mailed to Santa Fe and we are holding your Notice of Intention to Drill pending approval of the bond. In the meantime will you please advise the casing program you will use.
