Well drilled and completed 1949, in open hole from 3995' to 4343', well had become non-commercial, and was P&A 8-31-77. There were no other producing zones. The plugging procedure was witnessed by U.S.G.S. representative. Tubing was stuck, was cut off at 3500'. No. 1 plug of 25 sacks was placed thru tubing from 3500' to 3275' in 5 1/2" csg. Top of plug tagged and casing was circulated w/10% brine and mud. No. 2 plug thru tubing 25 sacks 2711'-2490'. No. 3 plug perforations (4 hole) made in 5 1/2" csg. at 1300', ran tubing mixed 75 sacks cement, 50 sacks pumped out thru perforations, leaving 25 sacks plug in 5 1/2" csg. 1300' -1100'. No. 4 plug 2 sacks 20'-0 in top 5 1/2" csg. steel cap welded on with marker. No casing pulled.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
