1. Move in and rig up pulling unit, pull rods and tubing, install BOPF.
2. Perforate 3814-3890 with 2 CJFF.
3. Run packer on 2-3/8" tubing to 3775'. Set packer. Will not load backside.
4. Rig up hot oiler, pump truck and ball injector.
5. Treat down tubing with 159 bbls. hot 2 percent hydroxyacetic acid. Inject ball sealers to raise surface pressure to 1000-2000 psi. Will not exceed 2900 psi frac pressure.
6. Shut well in for at least 24 hours.
7. Pull packer, run production string, place on production.

## Instructions

**General:** This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

**Item 4:** If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

**Item 17:** Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices. In addition, such proposals and reports should include reasons for the abandonment; data on any former or present productive zones, or other zones with present significant fluid contents not sealed off by cement or otherwise; depths (top and bottom) and method of placement of cement plugs; mud or other material placed between and above plugs; amount, size, method of parting of any casing; liner or tubing pulled and the depth to top of any left in the hole; method of closing top of well; and date well site conditioned for final inspection looking to approval of the abandonment.
