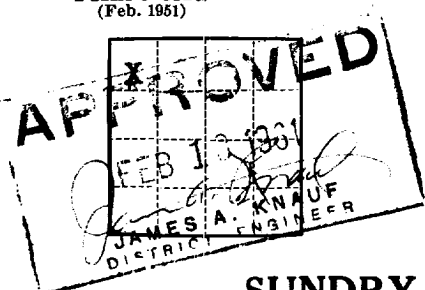

DETAILS OF WORK

Subject well was temporarily abandoned, on 12-30-60. The well contains 356' of 7 5/8" OD 24# H-40 casing set at 368', and 4160' of 4 1/2" OD 9.50# J-55 casing set at 4140'. Production casing is perforated from 3705-13' 3782-3826', 3850-92', 3944-55', 4128-36'. The well is not plugged, however complete wellhead equipment is installed. The location has been fully cleaned up and will be kept in a neat and orderly condition during the period of temporary abandonment. The well was temporarily abandoned, instead of permanently abandoned, in order to allow time for further study and evaluation before final disposition is made.
