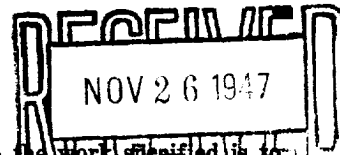

FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Total depth 4026' White Dolomite. Plan to plug back from 4026' T.D. to 3786' W/30 sks. cement, casing is set @ 3840' which will cement 54' up in casing. Hole will then be filled with heavy mud-laden fluid to surface. Will then shoot off 5½" csg. at top of cement outside of pipe (5½" csg. was cemented W/500 sks. cement), will place sand & gravel bridge and a 10 sax cement plug in top of 5½" csg. left in hole. Will then shoot off 8-5/8" csg. at top of cement outside of pipe (8-5/8" csg. was cemented W/300 sks.). Will place a sand and gravel bridge and a 10 sax cement plug in top of 8-5/8" casing left in hole. All intervals between plugs will be filled with heavy mud-laden fluid. Will fill the top 20' of the hole with a cement plug to surface with a 4" pipe marker set in the cement to extend 5' above ground level.
