DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On October 25, 1947 we shot this well from 4160 to 4286 with 320 quarts of nitro-glycerin in an attempt to increase production which had fallen to approximately 5 Bbls. per day. We cleaned out to 4286 with reverse circulation finishing this work on November 11, 1947. The result was an increase in production to approximately 15 Bbls. per day.
