SUBJECT: State O #22-F in Sec. 12, T17S, R32E

Dear Mr. McBride:

This letter is our third attempt to get something done about the proper temporary abandonment of your State O #22, a shutin injection well in the Maljamar Grayburg/San Andres Pool. We wrote to Monument Energy in 1982 and 1983 without receiving any response. The well has not been owned by Chaveroo Operating for over a year.

As you know, our rules require that injection wells which have been inactive for a period of 6 months or more should have the injection interval isolated by a cement plug or a CIBP and the casing pressure tested.


If you choose to leave the well as a shutin injection or disposal well you will need to set a CIBP above the injection interval and pressure test the casing within the next 60 days. We require 24-hour notice on this type work in order that we may witness.

Your other options are: (1) test the casing and put the well on production, (2) plug and abandon.

A reply will be expected within 2 weeks.
