## FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

The production from this well had declined to around ten barrels per day, and during the last several months considerable difficulty was experienced in keeping it flowing. The well was cleaned out in May der on June 14 put to pumping, and has been pumped daily since that time.

On October 10th the well was tested. During five hours it pumped 21 barrels of fluid, of which 5% was water, with a gas-oil ratio of 660 cu. ft. of gas per barrel of oil. The casing pressure was 580# at the start of test and 440# at completion. This is the present normal performance of the well.
