FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

T. D. 4075. This well drilled to 4075. Encountered a slight oil show 4045-4055. Shut well in 3 days and found 3 bailers oil, no water in hole. Dumped gravel from 4075-4052 and shot with 140 Quarts Solidified Nitro-Glycerin from 4000-4052. Cleaned out to bottom after shot. Recovered oil load and bailed 8 gallons oil, no water, 8 hours. Hole dry.

We therefore wish to cement with 25 sacks from 4075 - 4025 to cover the face of oil horizon. Heavy mud from 4025-3930. Cement with 20 sacks cement from 3930-3875 to cover bottom of oil string. Heavy mud from 3875-2090. Cement with 10 sacks from 2090-2060 to cover base of salt. Heavy mud from 2060 - 900. Cement with 35 sacks from 900-820 on top of salt. Heavy mud from 820 to bottom of cellar. Cement with 10 sacks cement from bottom of cellar to surface and set pipe marker.
