DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T. D. 4075 Line. Dumped gravel from 4075 to 4052'. Ran 140 Quarts Solidified Nitro-glycerin in three 4" x 11' and one 4" x 8' tin shells 4052-4000 using Bolshevik Umbrella and AG Double Action Time Bomb. Shot set to detonate 3:10 PM, October 18, 1941. Gravel tamp to 3965' with six sacks Calseal to 3924'. Hole loaded with oil. Shot detonated okay. Cleaned out to bottom. On 8 hour bailing test, well made 8 gallons oil, no water. Oil lead recovered prior to bailing test.
