In accordance with approval by phone from Mr. Inaaf on March 1, 1951, this well has been plugged as follows:
15 sacks of cement were spotted at bottom of hole to 5362'.
A 50 sack cement plug was placed from 4150-3988'.
A 10 sack plug was then placed from 2621-2589'.
Top of 8-5/8" casing is cased with swage and valve. The well will be temporarily abandoned, pending further development in this area.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
