On February 2, 1951 2000-7-12 ft. 2 1/2" H-40 OD 20# H-40 seamless steel casing was cemented in this well at 2000 ft. with 250 sacks of cement placed through the shoe at 2000', and 100 sacks of cement through a two-stage tool set at 750 ft. We will let the well stand for forty-eight hours for the cement to harden. At midnight February 4th the plug will be drilled and tests made for water shut-off. If the shut off is found to be complete drilling will then be resumed.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
