TD 4208. PHD 4186. Casing point 5 1/2" at 4208'. Grayburg-San Andres pay 3696-4007. Perforations 3995-4003. On the latest test the well flowed 9 BO, no water, with 50.4 MCF/GPD, GOR 5929.

Permission is requested to perforate intervals 3751-57, 3770-81, 3784-96, 3816-20, 3823-33 with 4 JSPP. Treat down 3" tubing with 60,000 gallons lease crude, 60,000 pounds sand, and 3,000 pounds "ADOMITE" using ball sealers.

A subsequent report will be submitted upon completion of the above work.
