TD 13,670' Lm., PBD 10,600', Pay Abo 8977-9020', Perfs. 8977-87', Csg. Pt. 7" at 13,642'. Present daily allowable and production is 102 BO. Well started producing water in September 1960. Analysis indicates this water to be from Wolfcamp formation. It is believed that packer at 9020', used to seal off Wolfcamp, has failed. A sinker bar run on wire line indicates tubing parted at 7000'. It is apparent that water from the Wolfcamp is highly corrosive.

In order to prevent further corrosion damage to the tubing string, and to return the well to a normal producing status, permission is requested to clean out to 10,500', squeeze Wolfcamp intervals 9850-62' and 9872-96', then to place the well back on production.

A subsequent report will be submitted upon completion of the above work.
