Permission is requested to perform the following work: Set DR plug in Baker Model D plug with sand and hydremite at 10,700'. Set bridge plug at 9868'. Perforate 9850-62' in Wolfcamp formation. Acidize with 10,000 gallons. Swab and test.

A subsequent report will be submitted upon completion of above.
