DETAILS OF WORK

Drilled 7 7/8 inch hole to 4324 in Line. Ran 5 1/2 inch 15.5# casing to 4323' and cemented with 300 sacks 50% Pozmix and 100 sacks regular cement. Plug down 11:30 A. M. 12-25-57. Released pressure after 12 hours and ran temperature survey. Found top of cement behind casing at 2310 feet and top of cement plug at 4294 feet. After WOC 48 hours pressure tested casing with 1000 pounds for 30 minutes, test OK. Picked up tubing and bit and drilled out cement to 4312'.
