Spudded 10:30 A.M. 1-17-59. Drilled 15" hole to 177 feet in Red Bed. Ran 10 3/4" casing to 176 feet and cemented with 175 sacks regular cement plus 2% calcium chloride. Cement circulated to surface. Plug down 5:00 P.M. 1-17-59. After WOC 24 hours, pressure tested casing with 1000# for 30 minutes, test OK. Drilled out plug with 7 7/8" bit at 7:00 P.M. 1-18-59.
