DETAILS OF WORK

This well was temporarily abandoned on 5-4-60. A report was filed on May 6, 1960 showing abandonment operations below 2200'. On June 14, 1961 we filed a form, "Notice of Intention To Abandon Well", which was approved June 19, 1961. We shot the 8-5/8" casing off at 2200' and pulled same. We spotted a 20 sack cement plug at 1084', which was at the top of the salt section. We placed 5 sacks of cement in top of the 13-3/8" surface casing and erected a permanent marker and leveled the location. The hole was filled with heavy mud between all plugs.
