DETAILS OF WORK

This well was temporarily abandoned on 5-4-60. A report was filed previously in connection with this operation. We propose to shoot the 8-5/8" O.D. casing off at the top of the cement which a temperature survey shows to be at 2200'. We will spot a 20 sack cement plug at the top of the salt section. The top of the salt was at 1084. We will pull the 8 5/8" O.D. casing and place a 5 sack cement plug in top of the 13 3/8" surface casing. A permanent marker will be erected and the location leveled. *H.M. before cement plug*
