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This form shall be executed and filed in quadruplicate with the Oil Conservation Commission at Santa Fe, New Mexico, covering each unit from which oil is produced. A separate certificate shall be filed for each transporter authorized to transport oil from a unit. After said certificate has been approved by the Oil Conservation Commission, whe copy shall be forwarded to he transporter, one copy returned to the producer, and two copies retained by the Oil Conservation Commission.

A new certificate shall be filed to cover each change in operating ownership and each change in the transporter, except that in the ense of a temporary change in the transporter involving less than the ellewable production for one month the operator shall in lieu of filing. How certificate, notify the Oil Conservation-Commission at Santa Fe. New Mexico, and the transporter authorized by certificate on file with the Commission, by letter of the estimated amount of oil to be moved by the transporter temporarily moving oil from the unit and the moved by the transporter temporary transporter. Such temporary transporter shall not move any more oil than the estimated amount shown to mid notice.

This certificate when p operly executed and approved by the Oil Conservation Commission shall constitute a permit for pipe line connection and authorization t> transport oil from the property maned therein and shall remain in jull force and effect until

- (c) The permit is cancelled by the Commission.
