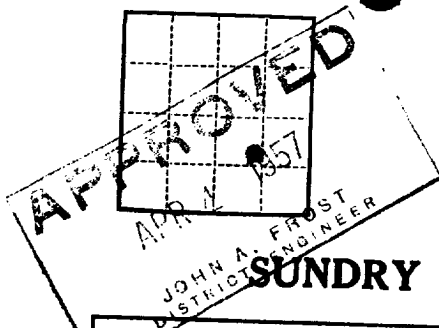

The elevation of the derrick floor above sea level is **3956.4** ft.

DETAILS OF WORK

This well was originally drilled through the Maljamar Pay to Total Depth of **4266'** in September 1954. **5-1/8"** casing was set @ **4265'** & cement circulated to surface behind casing. Cement inside casing is below the Maljamar Pay at approximately **4236'**. Casing was perforated into the Red Sand Section from **3339'** to **3351'** & well was sand-oil treated, but proved non-productive.

We now propose to recomplete this well in the Maljamar Pay by squeezing off the Red Sand Zone perforations, clean out well to top of cement plug, perforate casing in the Maljamar Pay and sand-oil treat with 20,000 gals. gelled lease crude & 20,000 sand, & place well on production.

This recompletion has been approved by letter from Mr. A. L. Porter, Jr. of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission.

A complete supplemental well history will be furnished on completion of work.
I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
