DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

This well was deepened from 3855' to 3992' with reverse circulation by Beckman, Inc. The 7th zone was drilled from 3866' to 3894'. The 8th zone from 3902' to 3988. This work was started June 21, 1946 and completed June 27, 1946. The well was not shot. A steel line measurement was run at the completion and a total depth of 3992' was recorded. This well has been an injection well but will now be changed to a producer. No test has been made on this well as yet. It is difficult to determine the zones in this well as they run together as you will notice from the depths shown. The 9th zone, shown at 3990' is just beginning to show up.
