DETAILS OF WORK

Moved in Cable Tools and cleaned well out to Total Depth of 4256' on 9-10-51. Then run Lane-Wells Gamma Ray & Neutron Survey and then run Dowell Caliper Survey. On 9-12-51 spotted 8 sacks of cement on bottom through tubing. Cementing done by Halliburton Oil Well Cementing Company. Let well stand for 72 hours for cement to set. Found top of cement at 4250'. On 9-12-51 dumped 1 sack of cement using Halliburton Oil Well Cementing Company Dump Bailer. Let well stand for 72 hours for cement to set. All cement used was inner quick-set cement. On 9-21-51 found top of cement at 4253'.

Production before cleaning out & plugging back: 15 BOVD & 1 bbl water in 2 hours. Production after cleaning out & plugging back: 25 BOVD & no water.
