Well was shut-in in May 1958 by Weier Drilling Company. It was acquired by W. A. Moncrief Jr, on 1/1/60. Pumping operations were started 11/18/60. Production was 100% water until May 1961. In May 1961, well pumped 18 barrels of oil and in June 1961 it pumped .66 barrels of oil. Production thereafter was 100% water. Pumping was discontinued in July 1961. Tubing was pulled and well temporarily abandoned. We plan to retain well in present status for possible future use in Maljamar Water Flood Unit.

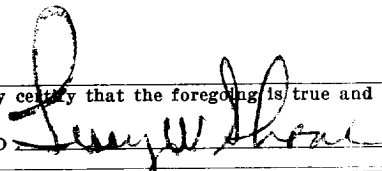
