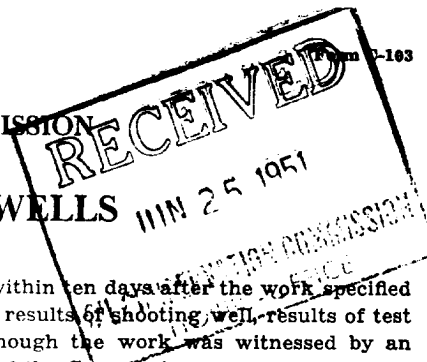

New Casing - Set at 9915' & cemented with 600 sacks of Trinity Infurne Slow Set Cement, mixed 3% Jell & 1/4# flow seal per sack. Plug to 9828' at 8:20 P.M., 6-20-51. Maximum pump pressure 1800#. Ran 7 - 5-1/2" Baker Centralizers, spaced 30' apart, from 9705' to 9885' and 14 - 5-1/2" Weatherford Scratchers, spaced 15' apart, in the above section.
