10010' - Total Depth - Line. Ran temperature Survey, found top of cement behind 5 1/2" casing at 6740', ratio of actual to calculated fill, 87.0%. Ran 2-3/8" OD tubing W/4-3/4" bit, checked top of cement @ 9924'. Tested casing and connections with 1000# for 1/2 hour - no pressure drop. Drilled cement plug from 9924' to 10005'. Tested casing & connections with 1000# for 1/2 hour - no pressure drop. Continued with completion operations.
