4205' Total Depth - 14me. Finished drilling 11" hole @ 2:15AM, 6-22-53. Ran a total of 110 jts. 8-5/8" OD Casing set @ 4175' & cemented w/ 1500 sk. cement. Pumped plug to 4108' @ 12:50PM, 6-22-53 with max. pump pressure of 1200#. Ran temperature survey, top of cement outside 8-5/8" Casing @ 1841' or 46.6% fill. After WOC for 24 hours, tested casing for 1/2 hour w/ 1000# - no pressure drop. Drilled cement plug from 4108' to 4175' and tested casing w/ 1000# for 1/2 hour - no pressure drop. Started drilling formation and 7-7/8" hole @ 3:00AM, 6-24-53.
