10125' Total Depth - Lime. Finished drilling 7-7/8" hole @ 4:15 AM, 10/7/52 -
Ran Schlumberger's Electrical, Gamma Ray and Microlog Surveys.
Ran a total of 287 Jts of 5-1/2" OD casing, set at 10010'
with 600 sx slt-set cement. Pumped plug to 9926' at 8:15 AM, 10-
9-52. Max pressure, 1700#. Ran temperature survey, found
top of cement outside 5 1/2" csg. @ 6004', or, 88.8% fill.
After WOC for 24 hours, tested casing W/1000# for 1/2 hour-
no pressure drop. Drilled cement from 9926' to 9995' and
tested casing for 1/2 hour W/1000# - no pressure drop.
