DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

This well was drilled to a total depth of 10,078' in lime. Ran 272 1/2 jts. (10064.02') of 5 1/2" OD 8R thd SS 17# N-80, 15.5# J-55 SS Csg. set at 10,076' and cemented with 550 sacks regular bulk cement mixed with 4% gel. Ran 70 Weatherford scratchers, 15 Weatherford centralizers from 9200' to TD. Ran float collar and guide shoe. Final pressure 1500#. Plug down 6:15 A.M. 1-25-53. Top cement at 6565' by temperature survey. Cement was allowed to set 48 hours before testing casing shut off. 1000# pressure applied with all valves closed with no drop in pressure during 30 minute period. Shut off found to be satisfactory.
