Ran Schlumberger's Electrical, Gamma Ray & Microlog Surveys - Ran 307 Jts of 5-1/2" OD Csg. set @ 10035' with 400 sx cement. Pumped Plug to 9943' at 11 AM, 7/29/52. After WOC 24 hours, checked top of cement @ 9943' - Drilled cement from 9943' to 10015'. Tested casing before and after drilling cement for 1/2 hour with 1000# - No pressure drop. Continued with Completion Operations -
