DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

10077' - Total Depth - Line. Ran Temperature Survey, found top of cement outside 5 1/2" casing at 6736', ratio of actual to calculated fill, 85.9%. Ran 2-3/8" OD tubing W/4-3/4" bit, checked top of cement @ 9886'. Tested casing and connections with 1200# 1/2 hour before drilling cement - no pressure drop. Drilled cement from 9886' to 9973' and tested casing for 1 1/2 hour with 1200# - no pressure drop. Continued with completion operations.
