DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Plugged as follows: 10,015 to 9965 with 20 sacks - 9100 to 9050 with 20 sacks - 4260 to 4160 with 40 sacks. A 4" OD pipe extending 4' above ground level was placed in top of 9 5/8 casing and cemented with 10 sacks cement. All plugs were placed with drill pipe by displacement and the space between plugs filled with 10.1#/gal. mud. No pipe was pulled from this well.
