FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

It is proposed to plug and abandon State "Z" #1 well. This well was completed September 2, 1951 with an initial production of 39.96 bbls of oil and .4% BS&W. Production is approximately 2.6 bbls of oil per day which is non-commercial since the cost of operation exceeds the income. It is proposed to cut off the 5½" casing at as low a point as it can be found free in the hole and the free casing pulled. The hole will then be loaded with heavy mud; 50 sacks of cement spotted in bottom of hole; 50 sacks spotted in the top of 5½" casing extending into open hole; 50 sacks in bottom of 8 5/8" casing, 10 sacks spotted in top of 8 5/8" casing. No attempt will be made to pull 8 5/8" casing. The cellar will be filled, surface equipment removed, location leveled and cleaned up and abandoned well marked with a 4" pipe marker cemented in the top of the old hole and left extending 4' above the surface and plugged on top.
