FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Test has been drilled to a depth of 5102' (3.L.M.) and found to contain no oil, gas or water in the limestone section. We therefore propose to plug and abandon the well by the following procedure:

The 5 1/2" casing, which was cemented at 4410' with 35 sacks will be shot off as near top of cement as possible and pulled. The hole will be bridged at this point and heavy mud filled to a point immediately below base of salt where hole will be bridged and a 10 sack cement plug set. Heavy mud will be used in filling the hole to top of salt where a bridge will be formed and 10 sacks of cement spotted on top of the bridge. We will be unable to pull the 8-5/8" casing and will therefore fill it to top with heavy mud with cement plug in top and 4" marker set in top of casing, extending 4' above ground.

Location site will be cleared of all debris and pits will be filled as required.
