DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

8 1/2" fourteen pound standard seamless casing was cemented at 4410' with 35 sacks of cement. After cement had set properly, casing was tested with 1000 pounds of pump pressure before plug was drilled and was found to be OK. Plug was then drilled and casing again tested with pump pressure. Both casing and cement job found to be OK.
