FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

We propose to run 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " fourteen pound standard seamless casing to a depth of approximately 4415' and cement with 35 sacks. If, when well is drilled to completion, commercial production is indicated we propose to gun perforate the 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " casing and cement with 150% of the calculated amount of cement^{as} required by the Oil Conservation Commission regulations.
