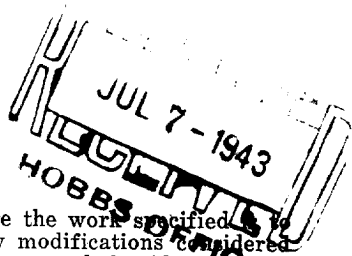

FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Hole was drilled with 7-7/8" bit to depth of 1438' then reamed with 12 1/4" bit to bottom and deepened with same to depth of 1496'.

We propose to set and cement approximately 1490' of second hand 8-5/8" 32# casing and allow cement to set 72 hours before drilling plug.

Casing will be cemented with 400 sacks. If such amount does not return cement to surface additional sacks will be pumped down outside casing through small line pipe if commercial production is indicated upon completion of well.
